SUMMARY

Data Validation (DV) Reports Web Software Release 1.2.0 has been installed on the Office of Unemployment Insurance (OUI) Internal Web site, <http://www.uis.doleta.gov/>. This release fixes the problem with the counts in Populations 10 and 11 and modified the "Year" drop box.

Fixes and Enhancements	
Benefits Populations 10 and 11 Average Age and Median Age counts are not getting displayed.	Made changes to data table and software to display counts as a decimal value.
Eliminate VY2009 from the Year drop-down list for both the State and Federal Reports applications.	Modified YEAR drop-down box to display years including next year with the current year starting from year 2010 because the software was displaying only partial data for VY2009. The database structure was changed during VY2009 and the software's queries could not retrieve data stored under the old structure.
Benefits Population 10 and 11 Average Age score are not being displayed.	Made changes to software to display the scores for Report cell 9055L/c9 and 9055H/c8.
